

Registration for the first European Job Market for economists is now open. The Job Market will take place on December 6 and 7, 2018, in Naples, Italy, immediately after the Econometric Society Winter Meetings.

Registration entitles you access to the following:

- Venues where the interviews will take place
- Social event on Wednesday, December 5 from 20:00 onwards
- Session on how to navigate the Job Market on Thursday, December 6 from 12:30-14:00
- Invited lecture given by Jean Tirole on Friday, December 7 from 11:30-13:00

Please note that the institutions interviewing (list updated on a daily basis at www.eeassoc.org) do not post their jobs on the EEA website. EEA's partner organization EconJobMarket.org - <https://econjobmarket.org> - handles the job advertisements. To access these postings, please sign up for free at <https://econjobmarket.org/login>. Please follow carefully the information and instructions for the job application on each job posting. Each institution will have its own distinct deadline for application and requests for information. Moreover, each institution will choose when to make their job announcement. The EEA will encourage them to post on EconJobMarket so do check this site regularly (and other sites where job postings are uploaded).

The EEA will not be involved in setting any job application deadline, nor will it be able to offer information or advice on the job posting of any institution. Moreover, the EEA will have no involvement in the scheduling of any interviews during the Job Market. Its role is limited to the organisation of the scientific and social events listed above.

Although one can register right up to the day before the Job Market begins, we do ask you to complete your registration by November 15, if you wish to access the social event and the scientific sessions. In fact, due to high demand for accommodation in December, you are encouraged to register and make your accommodation reservation and travel plans as soon as possible. Further information on accommodation can be found under Accommodation and Hotel Bookings on the EEA homepage.

Registration does not guarantee an interview. If a candidate does not get any interview, the EEA will refund the job market registration fee, if he/she decides not to participate.

The EEA has made 100 travel grants of €200 available. These travel grants are available to Job Market candidates whose departments cannot offer any resources for travel and accommodation. If you wish to apply, please write to admin@eeassoc.org with Job Market Travel Grant in the subject line (any other subject line may not be filtered) by October 31. Please include in your application a letter from your Head of Department confirming that the department has no resources for you. The travel grant will only be paid out as a reimbursement after the Job Market in Naples is closed to those who attended. If there are more applications than available grants, then the EEA will assign according to a lottery.
